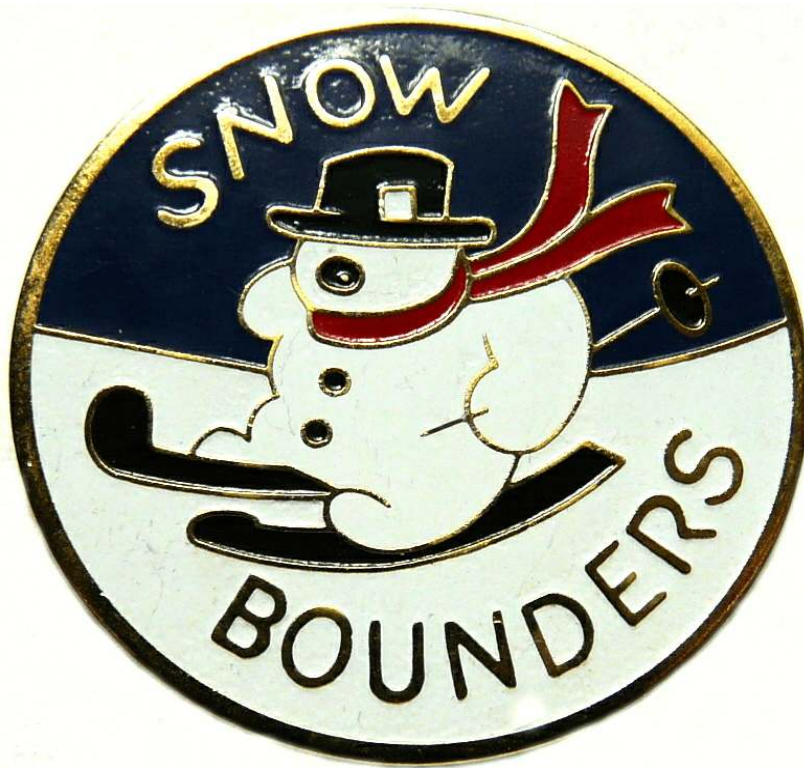

**FROM JAKE THE PREZ:** The Epic Winter Season of 2010-2011; What a winter – the snow gods have answered our prayers. The weather phenomenon La Nina was supposed to be dry for So. California but thanks to an extremely wet December, our rainfall averaged approximately 50% above normal. Some of our local ski areas were open into late April. The drought has been declared officially over and our lakes and reservoirs are near full capacity. Mammoth had received 316 inches of snowfall as of January 5 and 624 inches as of April 9<sup>th</sup> and could easily end the season with over 700 inches! Mammoth plans to be open until July 4<sup>th</sup>. As I compiled this newsletter on 5/1 the following is a non typical snow report for mid May:

California - Mammoth is open with 126 to 228 inches  
Squaw open with 155 to 165 inches  
Colorado - Arapahoe - still open with 54 inches and 15 inches fresh power in the last 72 hours  
Idaho - Brundage - limited open on 76 to 122 and 4 inches the last 72 hours  
Oregon - Mt. Bachelor 137 to 173 inches  
Timberline 195 inches  
Utah - Snowbird 0 to 167 inches  
Washington- Crystal 99 to 149 inches

Let's hope the snow gods are equally obliging for a great 2011-2012 ski season and for our long trip to Park City. BE SKIING YOU. PREZ JAKE

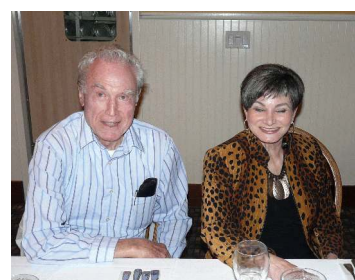
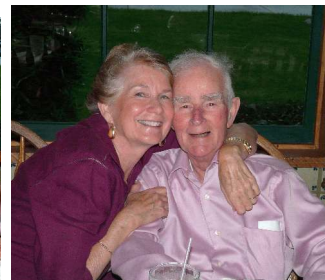
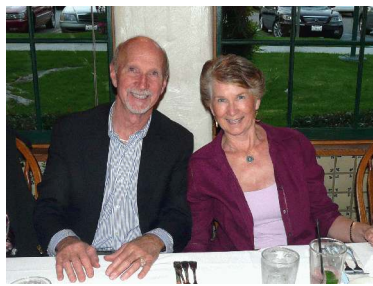
