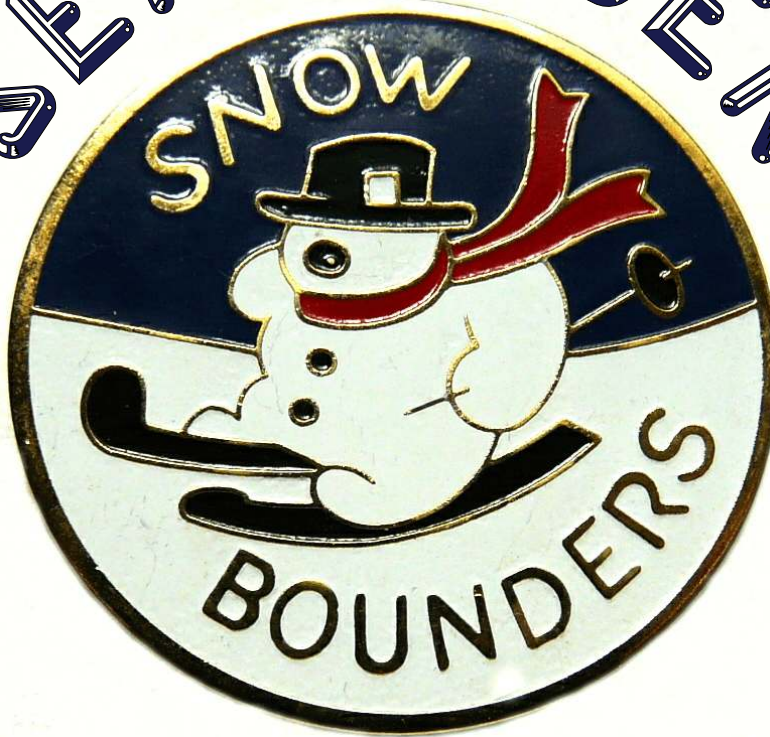

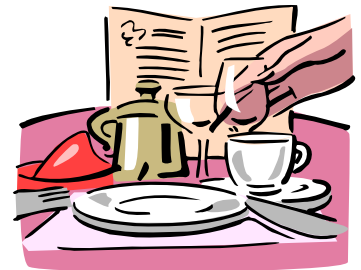

**MAMMOTH: Sunday-Friday, January 15-20, 2012.** We will be staying again at the Sierra Nevada Lodge. There are 7 kitchen suites reserved that will accommodate 28 of us. Three of the kitchen sides have a king bed and four have two queen beds. All of the adjoining rooms have two queen beds. The cost this year will be \$355 per person.
